- 3. Yahweh blinded man to their divine spark
- 4. The high god sent the redeemer to give gnosis **Gnostic Actions**:
- 1. Gnostics gave proof of salvation by asceticism
- Gnostics sinned to show salvation from the lower god's rules

Challenge: "You evangelicals focus on doctrine, we focus on love." 1st Corinthians 8:1-3 Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies. And if anyone thinks that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know. But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.
