The Situation of 2nd John

The Problem:

- The Supreme God did not directly create the material world. (physical material is evil)
- The divine Christ came down upon Jesus at baptism and left prior to crucifixion. (denial of the incarnation)

The Date: 90-93 A.D.

- 2nd John was written prior to 1st John?
- 1 John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not really of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us, but they went out, so that it would be shown that they all are not of us.

The Situation of 2nd John

The Recipient(s):

- 1. The "Chosen Lady" was a real person who had a family.
- 2. The "Chosen Lady" was a metaphor for the church universal.
- 3. The "Chosen Lady" was a metaphor for a local church in Asia Minor.

The Structure of 2nd John

Three Commands

- 1. "Love one another" (5)
- 2. "Watch yourselves" (8)
- 3. "Do not receive him" (10)

Five Contrasts

- 1. Walking in truth (4) vs. rejecting truth (7)
- 2. Command from beginning (5) vs. teaching that goes beyond Christ (9)
- 3. Work rewarded (8) vs. wicked works (11)
- 4. Continuing in Christ vs. not continuing (9)
- 5. Welcoming vs. not welcoming false teachers

John Greets A Church In Asia Minor


2 John 1-3 The elder to the chosen lady and her children, whom I love in truth; and not only I, but also all who know the truth, for the sake of the truth which abides in us and will be with us forever. Grace, mercy and peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

We Must Walk In Truth

2 John 4-6 I was very glad to find some of your children walking in truth, just as we have received commandment to do from the Father. Now I ask you, lady, not as though I were writing to you a new commandment, but the one which we have had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, that you should walk in it.

The Reason We Must Walk In Truth

2 John 7 For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist.



A Summary of The Heresy John Faced

- 1 John 2:22a Who is the liar, but the one who denies that Jesus is the Christ?
- 1 John 4:2-3 By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world.
- 1 John 5:6 This is the One who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood.

We Must Guard Against Heresy

2 John 8-9 Watch yourselves, that you do not lose what you have accomplished, but that you may receive full reward. Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son.

We Must Not Aid Heretics	
2 John 10-11 If anyone comes to you and does	
not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house, and do not give him a greeting;	
for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his evil deeds.

since He Himself was tempted in that which He has suffered, He is able to come to the aid

Jonah 2:9 Salvation is from Yahweh.	
John 8:58 Before Abraham was born, I am.	
2 Corinthians 5:18-19 Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself	
through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely that God was in Christ	
reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has	
committed to us the word of reconciliation.
