Paul Prays For The Elect At Colossae Colossians 1:9 For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding... 1. subjunctive = purpose result clause: Indicates both intention and certainty of accomplishment. 2. passive = God is the agent doing the filling. 3. "fullness" a concept that appears in 1:19, 24, 25; 2:2,3,9,10; 4:12, 17. Heretics claimed Christians needed "more" (i.e., angels) Paul Prays For The Elect At Colossae Colossians 1:9 For this reason also, since the day we heard of it, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding... Spiritual = emphatic adjective stating that both the wisdom and understanding is on the "spiritual level." This "spiritual wisdom and understanding" is contrasted with the heretics' counterfeit "philosophy" Col. 2:8, and "appearance of wisdom" Col. 2:23.

The Purpose of Paul's Prayer Colossians 1:10 so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; Contrast: Col. 1:21 And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds. Col. 3:7 and in them (evil deeds) you also once walked, when you were living in them The Purpose of Paul's Prayer Colossians 1:11-12a strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously giving thanks to the Father... A. Bearing fruit active passive B. Increasing in knowledge passive B. Strengthened in power active A. Giving thanks Read: Philippians 2:12-13 Jesus Has Rescued Us!
