



Jesus Has Rescued Us!


Colossians 1:12b-14 who (Father) has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light. For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of **His beloved Son**, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.


- ❖ Inheritance of the saints: Gen. 13:14-17, Num. 26: 52-56
- ❖ Rescued from domain of darkness: 2nd Cor. 4:3-4
- ❖ Redemption: Purchasing back what was lost
- ❖ Forgiveness of sins: Propitiation/Expiation




Let Us Walk Worthily!


- ❖ Paul prayed that the Colossians would walk in a worthy manner of the Lord who redeemed them. He also prayed that God would enable this to happen!
- ❖ Compatibilism: "Grant what thou commands, and command what thou wills" (Augustine).

The Invisible God Is Revealed!
Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of (over) all creation.
 1. Image: Gen. 1:26, 2nd Kings 11:18, Hos. 13:2
 2. Firstborn: Ex. 4:22 - read Esau/Jacob Genesis 25:23-34
Psalm 89:27-29 "I also shall make him My firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth. My *lovingkindness* I will keep for him forever, and My covenant shall be confirmed to him. So I will establish his **descendants forever** and his throne as the days of heaven."


Jesus Created Everything
Colossians 1:16 For **by** Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities – all things have been created **through** Him and **for** Him.

 **Jesus Sustains All Things**
Colossians 1:17 He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.


1. Before all things: John 8:58 (Yahweh)
 - Arius (there was a time when he was not)
 - Logically necessary: Law of Causality
2. Hold together: There is no such force as chance!

 **Jesus: Firstborn From The Dead**
Colossians 1:18 He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, **so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything.**

- ❖ Head of the body: 1st Corinthians 12:12-27
- ❖ Beginning/firstborn = Creator/Savior
- ❖ Firstborn from the dead = Preeminent

1. Jesus the first to have a glorified body!
2. Passover, Unleavened Bread, Firstfruits

 **The Fullness Of Deity Dwells In Jesus**
Colossians 1:19 **Because** in Him all the fullness was pleased to dwell. (Personal translation)
 Because: The reason for Christ's primacy given
 Fullness: 1:19, 24, 25; 2:2,3,9,10; 4:12, 17

The false teachers at Colossae taught that Christians needed "more" help than Christ could give. (Invocation of angels for protection)
 Dwell: Genesis 9:27; Psalm 2:4
 The Son is the God Who Dwells In Heaven!

Jesus Reconciled All Things

Colossians 1:20 and through Him to reconcile **all things** to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him. I say, whether things on the earth or things in heaven.

- ❖ Reconcile: apokatalasso- to bring back to harmony.
- ❖ Romans 8:22 -read
- ❖ all things: vs.16 all things created/ vs. 20 all things reconciled
- ❖ Reconciliation: Now- by faith/ Later – by force

Jesus Reconciled All Things


Colossians 1:20 and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace **through the blood of His cross**; through Him. I say, whether things on the earth or things in heaven.

Blood: symbolic of Christ's substitutionary death


Day Of Atonement
