A. In that day: God – faithful to remnant (20-23)

A. In that day: God – faithful like the past (26-27)

The Remnant Will Trust In Yahweh

Isaiah 10:20 Now in that day the **remnant** of Israel, and those of the house of Jacob who have escaped, will never again rely on the one who struck them, but will truly rely on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel.

Interpretive Issue

Isaiah 10:21-23 A remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God. For though your people, O Israel, may be like the sand of the sea, (only) a remnant within them will return; a destruction is determined, overflowing with righteousness. For a complete destruction, one that is decreed, the Lord GOD of hosts will execute in the midst of the whole land.

God Is Faithful To His Word!

Isaiah 10:21-23 (P.T.) A remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God. But your people, O Israel will be like the sand of the sea, (as) a remnant within them will return; a consummation is determined, overflowing with righteousness. For a complete fulfillment, one that is decreed, the Lord GOD of hosts will perform in the midst of the whole land.

God Is Faithful To His Word!

Genesis 22:16-17 By Myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son, indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies.

2 Timothy 2:11-13 It is a trustworthy statement: For if we died with Him, we will also live with Him; If we endure, we will also reign with Him; If we deny Him, He also will deny us; If we are unfaithful, **He remains faithful**, for He cannot deny Himself.

God's Remnant Should Not Fear

Isaiah 10:24-25 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD of hosts, "O My people who dwell in Zion, do not fear the Assyrian who strikes you with the rod and lifts up his staff against you, the way Egypt did. (NET) For very soon my fury will subside, and my anger will be directed toward their destruction."

God Remembers His Covenant

Isaiah 10:26-27 NKJV And the LORD of hosts will stir up a scourge for him like the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb; as His rod was on the sea, so will He lift it up in the manner of Egypt. It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed **because of the anointing oil**.

God Remembers His Covenant

Psalm 89:20-21 I have found David My servant; With My holy oil I have anointed him, With whom My hand will be established; My arm also will strengthen him.

<u>Isaiah 37:35</u> For I will defend this city to save it for My own sake and for My servant David's sake.

God Keeps A Remnant

Genesis 45:7 God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant in the earth, and to keep you alive by a great deliverance.

Isaiah 37:31-32 The surviving remnant of the house of Judah will again take root downward and bear fruit upward. For out of Jerusalem will go forth a remnant and out of Mount Zion survivors. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Who Is The Remnant Today?

Galatians 3:7-9 Therefore, be sure that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham. The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "All the nations will be blessed in you." So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

Who Is The Remnant Today?

Romans 9:6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel.

Romans 9:27-28 Though the number of the sons of Israel be like the sand of the sea, it is the remnant that will be saved; for the Lord will execute His word on the earth, thoroughly and quickly.

Are You Part of The Remnant?

>Forms of Deception: Trusting in idols

<u>Jeremiah 7:4</u> Do not trust in deceptive words, saying, 'This is the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD.

Acts 6:13-14 They put forward false witnesses who said, "This man incessantly speaks against this holy place and the Law; for we have heard him say that this Nazarene, Jesus, will destroy this place and alter the customs which Moses handed down to us."

- ➤ We're the majority!
- ➤ We're the chosen race!
- ➤ We're more spiritual!
- <u>2 Corinthians 13:5</u> Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you—unless indeed you fail the test?
