The LORD Is Worthy of Praise!

Exodus 15:21 Miriam answered them, "Sing to the LORD, for He is highly exalted; The horse and his rider He has hurled into the sea."

The Need To Give Thanks To God >Lack of Gratitude In The Garden:

Genesis 3:1 NKJV Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"

Genesis 3:6 When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate...

An Attitude of Trust

Philippians 4:6 **Be anxious for nothing**, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
