Israel's Pride Leads To Destruction

Isaiah 9:8-10 NKJV The Lord sent a word against Jacob, And **it has fallen on Israel**. All the people will know— Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria— Who say in pride and arrogance of heart: "The bricks have fallen down, But we will rebuild with hewn stones; The sycamores are cut down, But we will replace them with cedars."

### God Judges Israel's Pride

Isaiah 9:11-12 Therefore the LORD raises against them adversaries **from Rezin** and spurs their enemies on, the Arameans on the east and the Philistines on the west; and they devour Israel with gaping jaws. In spite of all this, His anger does not turn away And His hand is still stretched out.

### Human Pride Yields Evil Leadership

Isaiah 9:13-16 Yet the people do not turn back to Him who struck them, nor do they seek the LORD of hosts. So the LORD cuts off head and tail from Israel, Both palm branch and bulrush in a single day. The head is the elder and honorable man, and the prophet who teaches falsehood is the tail. For those who guide this people are leading them astray; and those who are guided by them are brought to confusion.

Jeremiah 5:31 The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests rule on their own authority; and My people love it so! But what will you do at the end of it?

Isaiah 9:20-21 They slice off what is on the right hand but still are hungry, And they eat what is on the left hand but they are not satisfied; Each of them eats the flesh of his own arm. **Manasseh devours Ephraim**, and Ephraim Manasseh, And together they are against Judah. In spite of all this, His anger does not turn away And His hand is still stretched out.
