Adam/Jesus Analogy

- Adam as God's son fails when tempted.
- Adam failed because he wanted to be like God.
- Adam's failure made all his sons sinners.
- Jesus as God's son overcomes temptation.
- Jesus was God but humbled Himself to become a man.
- Jesus' victory made all His sons righteous.



Israel/Jesus Analogy

- Israel was led by God into the wilderness, as was Jesus.
- Israel "rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit" (Isaiah 63:10), but Jesus was filled with the Holy Spirit and obeyed.
- Israel was allowed to hunger to learn one does not live by bread alone (Deut. 8:3).
- Israel was instructed to worship only God (Deut. 6:13).
- Israel was told to not put God to the test (Deut. 6:16).
- Unlike Israel, Jesus obeyed these Scriptures.
